Last Day of Term

Friday 17th July will be our last day before the summer break and we will be finishing early. Please see finish times below. Year 3 are due into school that day and in order that they get maximum time in school they are invited to attend Thursday 16th instead. Same gate, same time, just Thursday 16th!

We have now received further guidance from the government regarding the full opening of schools in September 2020. We are able to provide you with an update of how St Ives will look in September.

The new academic year begins on the 3rd September 2020 for all children apart from Reception and Nursery. Reception and Nursery will receive individual letters regarding transition and settle sessions during the first two days of term before starting full time on the 7th September. We look forward to welcoming all children back to school. The guidance states that bubbles will now be 'class bubbles' which allows the school to provide at least some consistent staffing throughout the school day. The rules regarding attendance will resume as of September, it is therefore expected that your child returns to school in the normal manner.

Staggered start and finish times will continue in September to ensure children do not mix with other children from a different 'bubble'. This will be between 8.40- 9am. You will be notified which time and gate your child will need to come in through nearer the time. Each class will be split in half and will be met by the class teacher or TA at two different gates, this allows for children to arrive and leave safely and swiftly. There will continue to be no parents on the school site and it will be your responsibility to adhere to social distancing whilst queuing and ensure only one adult drops off and picks up.

Breakfast School Club and After

This will resume from 3rd September with Breakfast club starting at 7.45am and After School club finishing at 6pm. Social distancing will be in place as much as possible for children in different year groups. Please book and pay online through Bookwhen.
